


Context

"The Authority shall prepare a regional transportation plan for Planning District 8 that includes transportation improvements of regional significance..."












Six Year Program

- Documentation





BRT Action Plan Adopted July 2025


- BRT Action Plan:

Other Contract Information

The procurement will be open and competitive RFP for technical services. NVTA will select the team that provides the best value.

- <u>Period of Performance</u>: five years two for TransAction, three for Six Year Program
- Additional Task Orders: Additional task orders may be issued as mutually agreed
- <u>Technology</u>: Contractor should be able to perform remote support to access NVTA IT environment with a tool of their choice via a cooperative support session
- Contract Type: professional services cost reimbursement basis for RFP defined tasks
