


NVTA's Primary Responsibilities



TransAction

- Long-Range Transportation Plan for NoVA
- Updated every five years
- Current plan adopted in October 2017



Six Year Program (SYP)

- Allocates NVTA's Regional Revenues to regional transportation projects
- Updated every two years
- Most recent SYP adopted in July 2020

5 Funding Programs to date

 106 Regional Multimodal Projects with total investment of nearly
 \$2.5 Billion

Vision

"Northern Virginia will plan for, and invest in, a safe, equitable, sustainable, and integrated multimodal transportation system that enhances quality of life, strengthens the economy, and builds resilience."

Core Values: Equity, Sustainability and Safety

- Summer 2022: Formal Public Comment Period on Draft TransAction Plan
- Summer/Fall 2022: Authority hosts Open House and Public Hearing
- Early Fall 2022: **Finalize** TransAction Update
- Late Fall 2022: Anticipated adoption of TransAction Update



Six Year Program Update Happening Now



Develop Six Year Program/FY2022-FY2027 SYP:

- 6th Funding Program
- Projects must be in TransAction
- 26 Candidate Projects, totaling more than
 \$1.2 Billion
- Applications received from 9 jurisdictions/localities
- SYP Primary Objective: Congestion reduction, guided by performance-based criteria
- Funds multimodal, regional transportation projects



TTSP - A tool that will inform a proactive approach to the adoption of transportation technology and:


- Provides a rational, consistent approach to identify how transportation technologies support the region's vision, i.e. needs-driven NOT technology-driven;

Regional Multi-Modal Mobility Program (RM3P)



- Partnership between NVTA and the Commonwealth of Virginia
- Adopt technologies to improve multimodal travel conditions
- Funded under the Commonwealth of Virginia's Innovative Technology and Transportation Fund (ITTF)

Mission:

 Leverage the collaborative use of real-time data by Virginia's public and private sectors to improve travel safety, reliability, and mobility, and to give the public the tools to make more informed travel choices.

What's Happening:

- Request for Qualification (RFQ) issued for Artificial Intelligencebased Decision Support System program element
- RFQ issued for the Dynamic Incentivization program element
- Continue development of this realtime data tool to improve safety, reliability, and mobility
- Includes development of:
 - Artificial Intelligence-Based Decision Support System
 - Dynamic Incentivization
 - Data-Exchange Platform
 - Commuter Parking and Information System
