Walter L. Alcorn is the Hunter Mill District Supervisor on the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors. He serves as Chair of the Board's Transportation Committee, as well as serving on the Boards of the Virginia Railway Express (VRE) and the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), and is an Alternate Director on the WMATA Board. He is also a Commissioner on the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission. Walter's focus is on transitoriented development, pedestrian/bicyclist mobility and safety, affordable housing and diversifying the local economy.

Prior to being elected to the Board of Supervisors and beginning his term in January 2020, Walter served on the county's Planning Commission for 16 years and also served on the Park Authority

Board. Professionally, he has worked on environmental issues in the tech industry and is a nationally-recognized expert on electronics recycling systems. Walter is a graduate of the University of Virginia and resides in Reston with his family.
