

Shirley Gate Road Extension

Braddock Road to Fairfax County Parkway







Project Description

The project will extend Shirley Gate Road as a four-lane minor arterial street between Braddock Road and Fairfax County Parkway (FCP), connecting with the future interchange of the Parkway and Popes Head Road at the future Fairfax County Park Access Road entrance. The new roadway will include two lanes for each direction and a sidewalk or trail on both sides.

This roadway extension was identified in the Fairfax County Comprehensive Plan to improve regional north-south travel in this area of the county and alleviate congestion along Braddock Road and the parallel Route 123 to the east. The Shirley Gate **Reference Number: 2018-020-0**



Road Extended Corridor Planning Study was recently completed to evaluate different alignment alternatives, assess traffic operational performance of both existing conditions and future conditions with the extension, and examine various impacts including property, access, noise and lighting, etc. The intersection configurations of the modified intersection – Braddock Road and Shirley Gate Road, and typical roadway cross section are shown below, and included as Attachments B and C, respectively.

Regional Impacts

- Reduce congestion along Fairfax County Parkway corridor
- Improve north-south travel
- Improve access to western portions of the City of Fairfax and the Fair Center area, both Regional Activity Centers
- Reduce traffic volumes along area roadways and intersections (Popes Head Road, Braddock Road, Route 123)
- Reduce travel times along Fairfax County Parkway and Popes Head Road
- Reduce delay and queuing at the Ox Road intersections
