RESTRICTING PUBLIC-PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION ACT PROPOSALS FROM BEING SUBMITTED TO THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) has adopted some or all of the seven regional taxes and fees detailed in NVTA Resolutions 01-08A, 01-08B, 01-08C, 01-08D, 01-08E, 01-08F, and 01-08G; and,

WHEREAS, the NVTA is charged with utilizing this revenue to fund and implement transportation projects; and,

WHEREAS, the NVTA will be working to develop a suggested project development process, project prioritization process (using previously adopted criteria) and six year project implementation program for NVTA by November 1, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, although PPTA proposals may be an effective project implementation tool, the NVTA does not currently have the staff capacity or approved guidelines to evaluate unsolicited Public-Private Transportation Act (PPTA) proposals in the project development process,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY NVTA THAT:

The NVTA will not accept unsolicited PPTA project proposals until the NVTA determines such proposals may be accepted.
