Christopher Zimmerman Elected Chairman of the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority

Christopher Zimmerman, Chairman of the Arlington County Board, was elected Chairman of the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority on Sept. 14. Zimmerman has served on NVTA since its creation in 2002, including the past two years as vice chairman.

Martin E. Nohe, a member of the Prince William Board of County Supervisors, was elected Vice Chairman of NVTA. He has represented Prince William County on NVTA for almost two years.

The NVTA thanked outgoing chairman David F. Snyder, who successfully led efforts to develop and approve the *TransAction 2030* regional transportation plan during the two years he served as NVTA chairman. Snyder is a member of the Falls Church City Council.

The Northern Virginia Transportation Authority was created by the General Assembly to develop regional transportation priorities, to serve as an advocate for the transportation needs of Northern Virginia before the state and federal governments, and to develop policies to improve air quality. The NVTA, which represents nine cities and counties, was also charged with developing a regional transportation plan, which is named *TransAction 2030* and was adopted by the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority last week.
