## **BACK (AND FORWARD) TO THE FUTURE: NORTHERN VIRGINIANS SOUND OFF ON TOMORROW'S TRANSPORTATION** *Survey Reveals Public Views on Current Conditions and Future Transportation Priorities*

**WHAT:** The iconic *Back to the Future II* movie featured a fictionalized view of transportation in the fall of 2015, as Marty McFly traveled through time to experience flying cars, hoverboards and drones. With the fall of 2015 now upon us, NVTA Chairman Marty Nohe will unveil a new public opinion survey on the future of transportation that shows nearly half of Northern Virginia residents believe self-driving cars will be on the road within a decade.

This and other results from the just-completed Northern Virginia Transportation Authority survey are being released to reveal Northern Virginians' perspectives on current travel conditions as well as future transportation priorities.

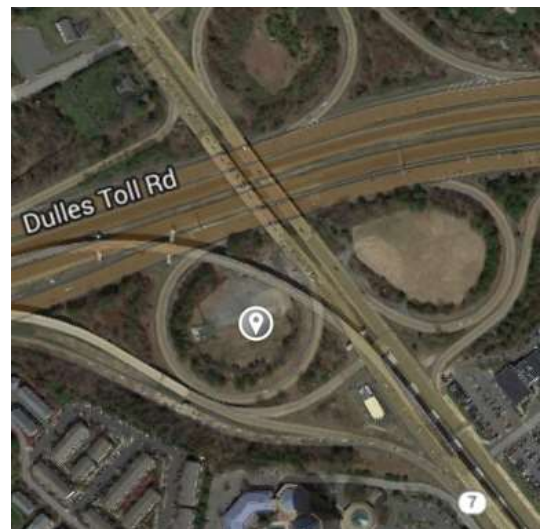
The release of the survey marks the start of an extensive effort by the NVTA to communicate with and involve the public in TransAction, the long range transportation plan for Northern Virginia.
